## PROCEEDINGS GUIDELINES

To ensure that high quality proceedings are published, authors are urged to take special care in preparing their papers.

Papers which are submitted in technically unsuitable form cannot be published in the conference proceedings.

Please use this checklist to ensure that guidelines are followed:

1. Page Size must be A4: $21 \times 29.7 \mathrm{~mm}$
2. Margins must be 2.5 cm (top and down), 3.0 cm (left and right)
3. Font Face must be Times New Roman
4. Font Size must be 12 point (except paper Title is 14 pt and Footnotes is $10 \mathrm{pt})$
5. Do NOT include PAGE NUMBERS
6. Do NOT include HEADERS or FOOTER
7. Do not start a new page for new sections (chapters) or subsections.

## STRUCTURE OF THE PAPERS

## Title/Subtitle block

Title (aligned left; all caps; 16 pt ; bold; no period) Subtitle (aligned left; under Title; all caps; 16 pt; bold; no full stop)

Two interval spaces (12 pt)

## Author/Affiliation/Email block

Author Name (aligned right; only capitalized on the first letter of each word; 14 pt )
Affiliation (aligned right; under Author; only capitalized on the first letter of each word; 14 pt )
Email (aligned right; under Affiliation)

Two interval spaces ( 12 pt )

## Abstract/Keywords/Resumo/Palavras-chave block

Start with "Abstract" (justified; 10 pt ; between 100 and 150 words)
An interval space (1opt)
Start with "Keywords" (justified; 10 pt ; between 4 and 6 words, separated by a semicolon)

Two interval spaces (1opt)
Start with "Resumo" (Portugês; justified; 10 pt ; between 100 and 150 words)

An interval space (1opt)
Start with "Palavras-chave" (Português; justified; between 4 and 6 words, separated by semicolons)

Three interval spaces (12 pt)

## Text/Images/Footnotes block

Maximum of 3 levels

1. Title (aligned left; 12 pt ; bold)
1.1. Title (aligned left; 12 pt ; bold)
1.1.1. Title (aligned left; 12 pt ; bold)

Images, charts, graphics, schemes (centered; lower caption; 12 pt )

Footnotes (justified; 10 pt ; cardinal numbered)

List of references according to the APA system, 7 th edition
Only references actually existing in the text should be part of the list

## Acknowledgments block

Placed at the end of the article, four spaces after the References (begin with "Acknowledgements"; justified; 10 pt )
